



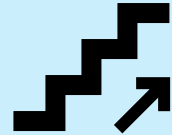
# PARENT / GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES



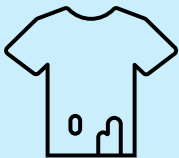
Remembers, their child plays rugby for their enjoyment & development



Praises good play, teamwork and sportspersonship across all teams



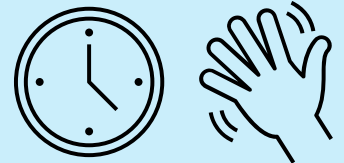
Focuses on effort and positives beyond just outcomes



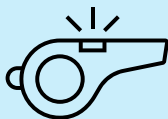
Ensures their child has the right kit<sup>1</sup> e.g. clothes, footwear, waterbottle, gumshields<sup>2</sup>



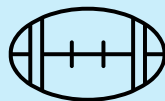
Registers their child on the RFU GMS system, including emergency contact details



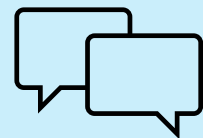
Is punctual and actively supports their child's learning during training and matches<sup>3</sup>
